

Resizing Picture Tool For Windows XP, 2000, Vista, and Windows 7

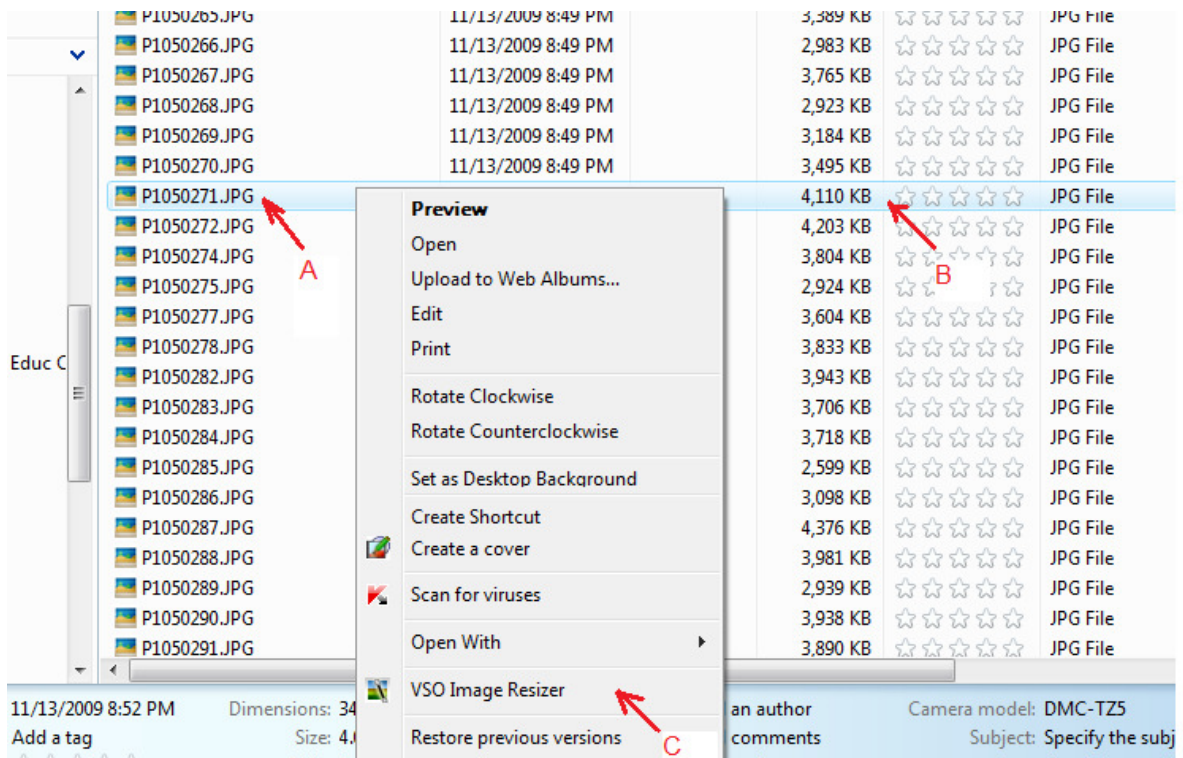
Use the below tool to resize your very large digital pictures by 90% or more without losing noticeable picture quality. Create small enough files to easily share via email.

Using VSO Image Resizer (Free Download)

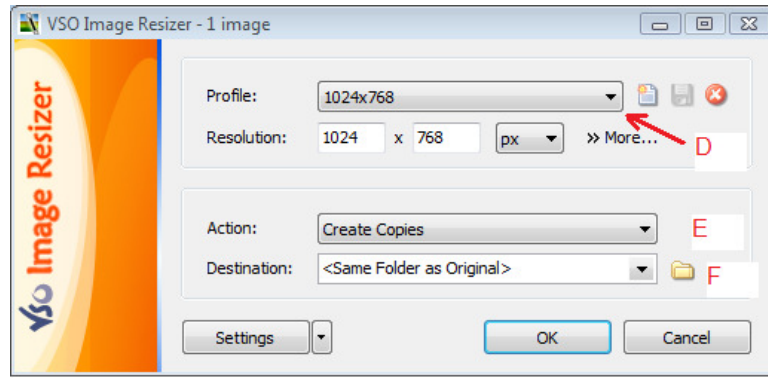
1. Download this freeware program to your local hard drive from:

http://www.vso-software.fr/products/image_resizer/download-image-resizer.php

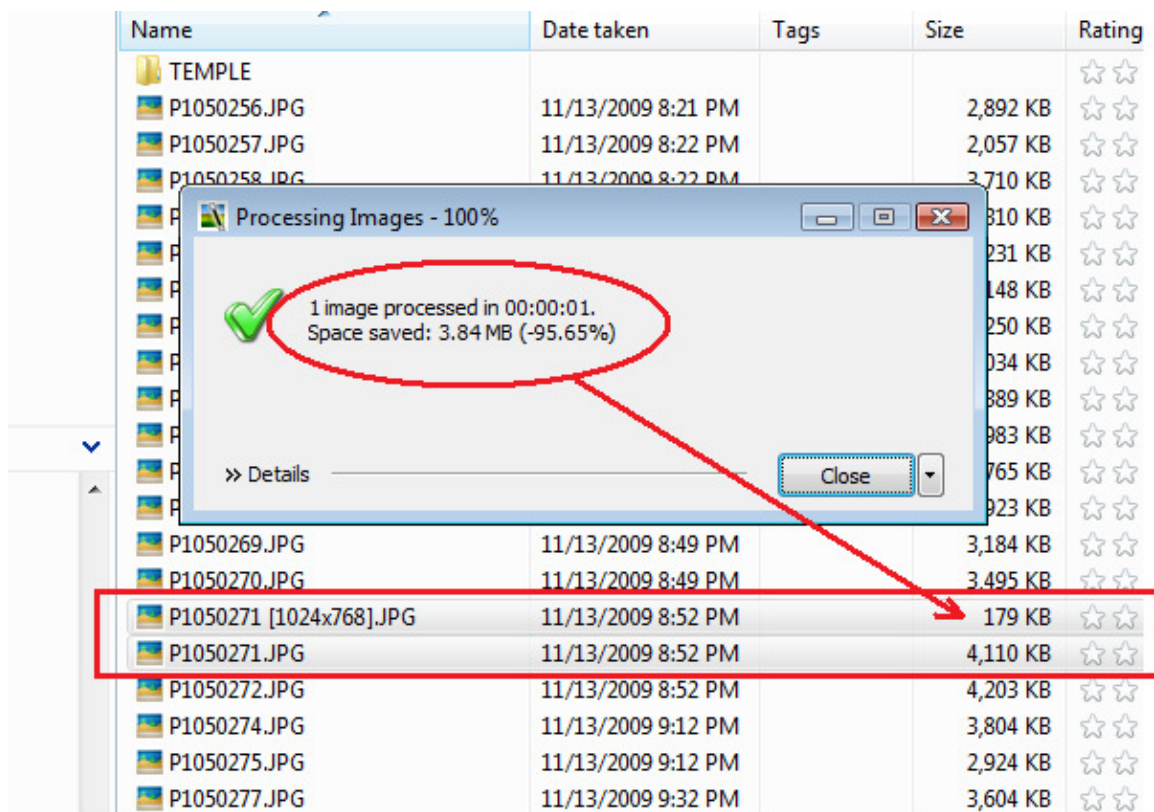
2. Run the program file **vso_image_resizer3_setup.exe** to install on your PC.
3. Using Microsoft Explorer find your picture(s). You will need to change the View Menu to "Details" to see the file size.
4. Select one or more files (A), in this case notice the file size is fairly large (B = 4110KB=4MB); right-click on it with the mouse and select VSO Image Resizer (C) from the menu.



5. The below VSO Program window will pop up on the screen. Select a Profile (D) for the resolution you want to resize your picture(s), 1024x768 for example.



6. Make sure “Create Copies” is selected from the Action menu (E) if you don’t want to resize the original file.
7. Either keep the Destination (F) the “Same Folder as Original” or browse to a different folder.
8. Select OK to resize the selected picture(s).



9. Notice the savings in file size, in this case over 95% from over 4MB down to 179KB.
10. You can now easily attach this file (or multiple files you’ve resized) to an email for easy sharing.
