Navajo: The Navajo had an outing as well as a bead meeting.

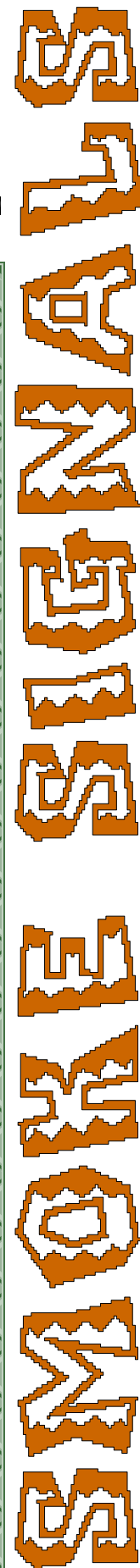
Tribe meets 1st & 3rd Thursday, Monthly-7pm

Sioux: The Sioux tribe had a bead meeting and a small outing.

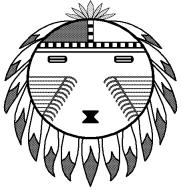
