Deadlines: **February 17, 2005** – Must Register Online before 5:00PM

Things to Bring: Tire Chains, sleeping bags, pillows, soap, towels, extra gloves and socks, boots, jackets, sunscreen, cameras, sunglasses, etc. Some years SNOW, some years NO. Extra clothing is highly recommended. See the 2006 Travel Package on the above website for a detailed packing list.
