



Fall Campout-Camp Fox on Catalina Island

November 14 - 16, 2003

The adventure begins on 11/14/03 when the *Catalina Flyer* departs from their dock in Balboa. Everyone needs to be at the dock before noon. DAILY EVENTS:

- **Friday:** Arrive 3pm or later, receive cabin assignments and unpack, dinner in the cafeteria, campfire for OBS, skits for OBN, followed by a movie and snacks in the cafeteria
- **Saturday:** Breakfast, lunch and dinner in the cafeteria, high ropes, archery, hiking, beach activities, scavenger hunt and prizes, lawn games and prizes, campfire for OBN, skits for OBS, followed by a movie and snacks in the cafeteria
- **Sunday:** Breakfast in the cafeteria, beach activities, pack and board the *Catalina Flyer* at noon for departure and the cruise back to Balboa for arrival about 3pm.

Cost: Per person (dads and daughters only)

\$120 per person if paid before October 31st

\$130 per person if paid after October 31st

Payment: Make checks payable to "COC - YMCA" or pay by credit card with the COC YMCA. Checks/Payment info should be given to your Tribe's Wampum Bearer as soon as possible. Tribe Wampum Bearers should submit a roster with payments to your Nation's Wampum Bearer before October 31st.
